Upgrade of windows and bathrooms – The Committee has finally been able to arrange inspections of the windows and bathrooms at the Lodge, with a view to developing and submitting a development application for upgrades later this year. Further updates about this work will be provided once the inspections have taken place.

Cot mattresses – The Committee has purchased 5 x fold-up toddler mattresses. These are for children under 5 years old, noting children 5 years and over are entitled to a bed. Use of these mattresses will be on a first come, first served basis. They cannot be reserved. They will be stored under the bunk beds in rooms 5 and 6. Please ensure you bring a waterproof bed covering if you intend to use one of these mattresses during your stay.

Sauna repairs – The repairs on the sauna are going ahead in early April. If all goes to plan, the sauna *should* be operational in time for the winter season.

Internet – A new Starlink internet system will be installed at the Lodge this coming weekend. This should enable use of the recently installed smart tvs.

Firewood – Delivery of firewood has been postponed from March to May, in time for the May work party.
